In the centre, also there is the Yarborough Hotel (a Wetherspoons Hotel) and St James's Hotel (both are in close walking distance of the Holiday Inn). Sunday, 1 August: For those stopping over, why not join Lincs Quest on their visit to Whisby Country Park at Lincoln. This site is owned by the Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust and is full of wildlife, trails and lakes. It offers walks which include lake views, woodland and meadows. Most tracks are hard-surfaced and routes are colour-arrowed. You can enjoy a short stroll or a longer walk. Why not also visit the Boardwalk Café for refreshments. Meeting time is 11 am and it is about 1 hour from Grimsby, south of Lincoln, just off the A46 (Moor Lane, Thorpe on the Hill, Lincoln LN6 9BW).
