Motions Adopted by the Conference.

A] Constitution and Standing Orders

The conference adopted the draft constitution; standing orders for National, Area, Second tier groups and group. The vote in favour was overwhelming

B] Name Change

Barkingside Eighteen Plus group proposed a motion to remove the word "Eighteen" from the principle name of the Federation. This was adopted by the conference.

C] Delegate Participation at General Meeting

Barkingside Eighteen Plus Group proposed motions to allow group delegate participation at a General Meeting. These were adopted by the conference.

Motions Lost

A] Proportion of vote needed to pass a constitutional vote

The NEC proposed a motion to lower the portion of the total vote required to pass a constitutional motion from seventy five to sixty six per cent for the length of the conference. This was not adopted and consequently all constitutional motions passed had achieved over seventy-five per cent
